Do you still have a couple of nice feathers hidden away somewhere? Add them to the headdress for an adventurous look!

### Party hats

are guaranteed to liven up any birthday party! This one is extra special as it looks just like a tribal headdress. Make two versions: a big one for the birthday boy or girl and some smaller ones for the guests. Do you have a table full of children? Letting them cut their own party hats before they eat the cake is perfect to get them into the party mood.

Cut a cardboard strip of about 15 cm in width and long enough to fit around your child's head, allowing some room for overlap. For the smaller headdress you can cut a slightly narrower strip. When making the big birthday hat, start from the middle of the headband and staple the largest leaf to the cardboard first. Then you staple on the other leaves, in decreasing size order. Use double-sided tape to attach the last leaf so that the staples are not visible on the outside.
