

All it takes to make your own leaf bunting

is a piece of sisal string (for a basic and natural look) or beautiful ribbon and an hour to cut about thirty leaves. Use a hole punch to make holes in the paper leaves and thread the leaves onto the string, alternating small and larger ones!

Styling idea

You can make your bunting as long as you like by varying the distance between the leaves. There is no need to hide the string or ribbon from view. For an extra festive touch, you can hang thin strips of coloured crepe paper between the leaves.
